



Poster Competition Information and Entry Criteria

The National Water Week Poster Competition is on again and this year's theme is
“Water – the heart of our culture”

Primary School students from around Australia are asked to create a poster reflecting water related issues which are important and relevant to them and their local area.

Teachers – this is a great activity for the classroom in the lead up to National Water Week.

Last year thousands of poster entries were received from Victorian Primary Schools, and hundreds came from our local Bass Coast area primary schools.

Poster entries are invited in four categories:

1) Prep / Foundation 2) Years 1 & 2 3) Years 3 & 4 4) Years 5 & 6

- At state level **\$300 cash** is awarded to the **school** that the first place poster came from and
- **\$150 cash** is awarded to the **school** that the second place poster came from.

Kids – entries will be judged locally with winners in each category submitted for state judging.

- **Great prizes** can be won at our **local level** for both winners and runners up.
- Prizes at the **state level** judging are:
 - **\$500 cash** for the first place student recipient in each of the four categories
 - **\$250 cash** for the second place student recipient in each of the four categories
- State winners then go on to the National level to find overall National winners in each age group.

Winners will be chosen using the following criteria:

- How well the poster conveys water related issues **relevant to your area** ie; inland school posters would not be focussed on ocean activities.
- How well it can be reproduced as an official poster to promote National Water Week.
- Appearance: attractively displayed in colour.
- How good it looks from a distance
- Effective use of art materials.
- Originality of design or innovative concept.
- One entry per student.
- One student per poster.

Entry criteria:

- **Poster MUST be A3 (30x40cm) in size**
- **Any** medium, including paper, can be used.
- **Any** art material can be used including paint, textas, coloured pencils or collage materials.
- An official entry form **must** be securely attached to the back of each poster.
- Entries must reach Westernport Water by **4pm Friday 1st September 2017**.
