What is an Environment and Sustainability Traineeship?

The Environment and Sustainability Traineeship will give you the chance to gain new skills and enhance your knowledge in the field of environment and sustainability, with full-time paid work and regular training through a registered training organisation, with the aim of obtaining a Certificate in Conservation and Land Management.

The traineeship includes:

- two years full-time work, paid in accordance with the relevant award
- training both on the job and formal accredited training
- a mentor to support your ongoing learning
- all training expenses fully paid

What training will I receive?

Formal training will be provided on a part time basis through Chisholm Institute. The remaining work days will be spent gaining hands on experience with Westernport Water, with indoor and outdoor activities, and there will be opportunities to work with other local natural resource management providers.

Who is this traineeship for?

Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people who:

- enjoy working in the natural environment
- want to learn more about the operations of water and waste water treatment
- are eager to gain hands on experience in land management activities such as revegetation, growth and performance assessment of tree plantations, biodiversity studies and waterway observations
- are committed to completing a Certificate in Conservation and Land Management
