


Water Operations & Maintenance Traineeship

What is an Operations & Maintenance Traineeship?

The Operations & Maintenance Traineeship will give you the chance to learn new skills and gain a qualification in Water Industry Operations (Certificate II). Running over two years, the traineeship combines full-time paid work with regular training through a registered training organisation.

The traineeship includes:

- two years full-time work, paid in accordance with the relevant award
- training both on the job and formal accredited training
- a mentor to support your ongoing learning
- all training expenses fully paid

What training will I receive?

Formal training will be provided on a part time basis through Chisholm Institute, with the remaining work days spent gaining hands on experience with Westernport Water, with indoor and outdoor activities across our various water and wastewater treatment plant sites.

Who is this traineeship for?

People who have an interest in:

- practical and mechanical activities and working in the natural environment
- learning more about the operations of water and wastewater treatment
- gaining experience in a wide range of treatment plant and maintenance activities such as identifying, locating and protecting underground services
- completing further/ higher education
