Customers please be aware that the drinking water supply should not be relied on in an emergency.



It's important to remember that the drinking water supply is not intended to provide fire-fighting capability, and we cannot guarantee water pressure in the event of a bushfire.

Residents who decide to stay and defend their property should be prepared with a carefully considered bushfire plan and access to an alternative water supply.

The CFA recommends residents who choose to stay and defend their property have:

- at least 10,000 litres of water
- firefighting hoses
- a generator to pump water.
