

Reconciliation Artwork

Westernport Water is seeking to commission a Bunurong or locally connected Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander artist or collectives, to create an original artwork supporting its next Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP).

Project Information

The artwork will reflect connection to Country, water, culture and community, and will be displayed in a public-facing workplace space and used across digital, print and community engagement materials.

Artists may propose works such as paintings, murals, sculptures or designs suitable for reproduction. The final scope, format and location will be developed in collaboration with the selected artist.

Artist's Fee

This is a paid commission with a total budget of \$5,000 (excl. GST). The fee covers concept development, artwork creation, materials and supplies, and agreed licensing for a five-year usage period. Remuneration will align with industry standards and recognise the cultural and creative value of the work.

Artists are invited to submit:

- a short biography with examples of previous work
- a brief concept outline (written or visual)
- optional information on cultural or community connections.
